Be part of the Meeting Centres UK family blanket!

We need your help. We were looking for a way to celebrate the ever-growing Meeting Centres UK family and we thought it would be fun to create a blanket. It will comprise separate squares from different Meeting Centres, which we will fit together to form a wonderful representation of the Meeting Centres UK family. We'd like Meeting Centres across the UK to get involved, so here is what you need to know:

- Each square should be **8 inches by 8 inches**, and each Meeting Centre can send in **up to 3 squares**. You can create as many as you want, but please only send 3!
- We'd like your square(s) to **represent your Meeting Centre**, so it can be as simple or crazy as you like. It can be a picture, a logo, a selection of words, it's up to you.
- You can use **all sorts of different media** including paper, wool and material – it can be knitted, crocheted, embroidered, quilted, a drawing, a painting, a collage, whatever works best for you. Our only advice is that it should not be too heavy and should work as an image to look at from the front (i.e. as if the blanket was hung up), so please don't create a 3D model that you have to view from the side – or at least don't send that to us as we won't be able to use it!
- You can send your completed squares to us using our **FREEPOST address** (see the bottom of this flyer). Please make sure you include a note to **say which Meeting Centre the squares are from** and indicate which is the top edge of the square to help us avoid any embarrassing mistakes when we're putting them all together.
- The **closing date is 21st June 2023** which should give you plenty of time, but you can send your square(s) in at any point before then.

So, get everyone involved and see what you can come up with. Please remember this is not a competition between Meeting Centres, but a celebration so we want you to enjoy it. If you cannot or do not want to take part for any reason, that's perfectly fine.
